"Disneyland" - WP: 24 d 00.871' N, 109d 48.336' W depth 37' to 80', swim to the east along wall of boulders to unique formations drop offs, pinnacles, windows, swim thrus NO HUNTING! FISH ARE FRIENDLY

Los Islotes

WP: 24 d 35.822' N. 110 d 24.200'W snorkel and dive, depth: 10' to 60' sea lion rookery, large swim thru strong currents possible anchor in 60', take dinghy to dive site

Wreck Dive "Lapas No 3"

WP: 24 d 28.731' N, 110 d 23.850' W anchor at Isla Ballena, take dinghy to dive site depth: 60', highest point at 30' 118' Chinese vessel sunk in 1999 as artificial reef, cleared for safe diving

Wreck Dive "Navy ship"

WP: 25 D 46.909' N, 111 d 18.069' W outside Puerto Escondido harbor depth: 35' to 72' sunk in 2003, cleared for safe diving

Isla San Diego WP: 25 d 11.746' N, 110 d 41.895" W
San Dieguito Reef - exposed reef off southwest point of island depth: 45'
abundant plant and fish life caves, swim thrus ... take good light!

"Pelican Rock" WP: 25 d 30.067' N, 111 d 00.494' W exposed reef system, lying north/south direction steep, narrow canyons depth: to 55' strong currents possible

Agua Verde

"Roca Solitaria"

Isla Carmen

""Aquarium" at Puerto Ballandra
No way points but located at south entrance to Puerto Ballandra
Lot's of sea life, great for snorkeling
NO SPEARFISHING – LORETO NATIONAL PARK!

Isla San Marcos

Piedra Blanca - WP: 27 d 14.033' N, 112 d 06.241' W snorkel and dive, depth: 30' column formations abundant plant and sea life great for night dive

Isla Salsipuedes

North Slot - WP: 28 d 43.643' N, 112 d 57.209' W snorkel anchorage, dive entrance - depth 40' to 60' large pinnacles abundant plant and sea life

Animas Slot

exposed reef off southeast point - WP: 28 d 50.41' N, 113 d 14.72' W depth: 40' to 90' or more steep formations abundant plant and sea life strong currents possible
