  - Still need a power supply and an antenna for the VHF radio donated for use at La Costa; have received estimates for purchasing these items. There was a discussion on why a VHF radio is needed at La Costa. It was suggested that instead of purchasing an antenna and power supply that a request be made on the morning net for donations of these items.
